

Powell Elementary Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten Roundup Week April 2rd – 6th, 2018

Pre-Kindergarten

Your child must be 4 years of age by September 1, 2018, to enroll for Pre-Kindergarten. This program is only available to those who qualify based on Limited English Proficiency, Homeless, Active Member of the Armed Forces, Educationally Disadvantaged, or Foster Child Placement. It is a half day program either in the AM from 7:50-10:50 or the PM from 12:05-3:10 depending on your address. For those applying based on Limited English Proficiency, a verbal test will be administered once all registration requirements have been submitted.

Kindergarten

Your child must be 5 years of age by September 1, 2018, to enroll for Kindergarten.

Beginning on March 24, 2018, you will be able to complete an online registration application for your child. Registration requires this online application as well as coming into Powell to present all documentation to complete the process. No paper registration applications are available.

We are offering a one-stop opportunity on April 5th, from 4:30-6:00pm for you to come in, present your documentation, get a tour of the school, meet our teachers and administrators, and have all of your questions answered. We will also have computers available to submit your online application in the event you do not have internet access. **Please make sure to bring all required documents or you will not be able to register your child.**

If you are unable to make this event, you will need to finish your enrollment during school hours throughout the rest of this school year. (8:00am-3:00pm M-F) Unfortunately, we won't be able to offer any tours or meetings with teachers or administrators, but will be able to answer all questions you may have.

To get ready now, please compile the following documents necessary to enroll:

- Original Birth Certificate
- Original SS Card or Passport
- Proof of Residency (utility bill or lease if renting)
- Valid ID of Parent/Guardian of student
- Immunization Record
 - DTaP (Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis) - at least 4 doses with the last shot given after the 4th birthday
 - Polio/Poliomyelitis - at least 3 doses with the last shot given after the 4th birthday
 - Hepatitis A - Series of 2 separate doses given 6 months apart after the 1st birthday
 - Hepatitis B - 3 doses (not the same as HIB)
 - MMR(Measles, Mumps, Rubella) - 2 doses both received after the 1st birthday
 - Varicella (Chicken Pox) - 2 doses after the 1st birthday or documentation of the disease by parent or physician
